


John Sanders thanked the many NMK members who volunteered for the Amgen race this past Monday. He said the event was well attended and it would not have been as successful without all the volunteers.

PROGRAM

Rosie's Journey of Hope was our program today. Cathy Calvin (president and founder) and Nancy Miller (board member) were very passionate about this. Rosie's Journey of Hope is a riding facility located in Oakdale. Therapeutic Horsemanship is a unique and intense form of therapy that quickly increases the strength and coordination of our special students. It's an excellent and productive way to increase stability, muscle control and emotional health. It is required that four volunteers are with each rider for safety reasons. These horses are well trained and have the temperament needed to provide a safe environment to the children and adults with disabilities. Each session lasts six weeks and many of the clients come back each year. Unfortunately, it is seasonal due to the fact that they don't have a covered arena. Each six-week session costs \$240. Scholarships are available for those who can't afford the cost.

MARBLE DRAW


Allan Ramsay—again! He picked the wrong marble though and walked away with NADA!
