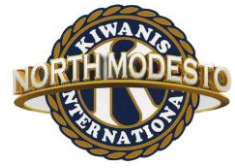

All the birthday boys were absent.

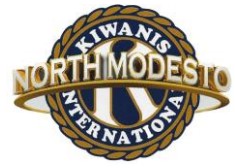
Wedding anniversaries:

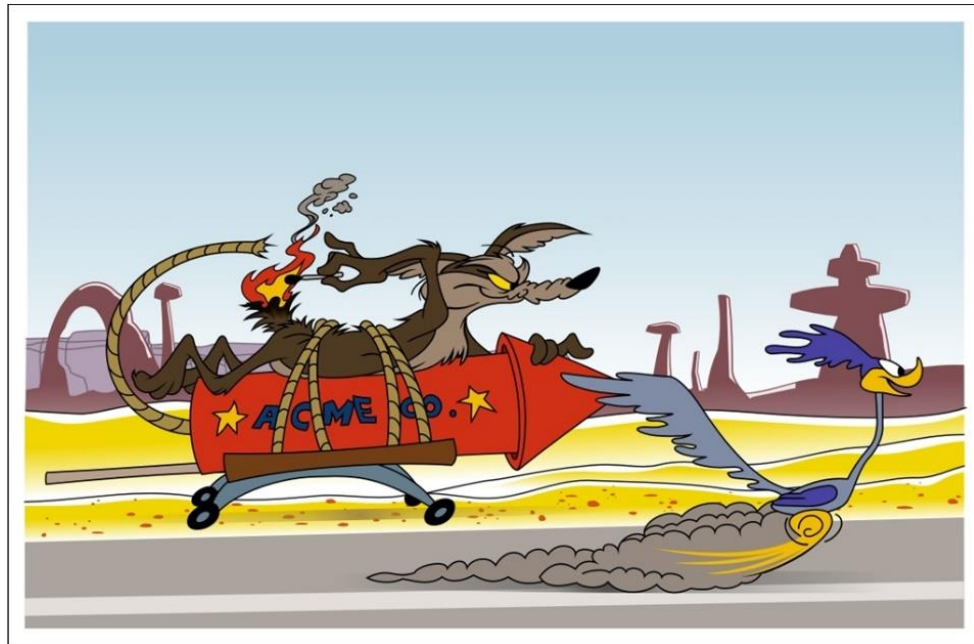
