PROGRAM

Dr. Elizabeth Demichelis briefed us on a California Dental Association community clinic to be held in Modesto Oct. 26 and 27.

Almost a third of Californians face some kind of barriers to dental care, ranging from language limitations to financial to a lack of transportation. Since 2012, the CDE has been offered twice-a-year clinics around the statement, where volunteer dentists, hygienists and oral surgeon treat up to 2,000 people in just two days. The services that will be offered include cleanings, fillings, extractions, limited root canals, some dentures and oral cancer screenings.

Exit interviews from previous clinics show about 28 percent of the people who attend who have dental pain, many of them for over a year. Eighty-three percent have no dental insurance.

The clinics are not just for the homeless but for the working poor and other people who do not have access to a dentist. It takes about 900 dental health professionals and 900 volunteers to put on the clinic.


