- 11:00 - 11:30 El Vista Ave at 450 El Vista Ave.

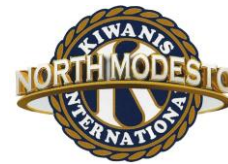

John Sanders reported that Pat Ramsay's family has lost 3 houses in the fire.

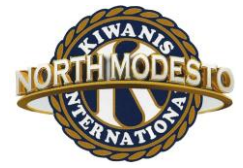
Eric Angelo was a proud dad. His son Robbie is playing his last college soccer game and looking to graduate school.

PROGRAM

An update on The Boys and Girls Club of Stanislaus County was presented by Veronica Jacuinde, Marketing and Communications Coordinator. The national organization started in 1860 and now serves over 4 million kids. The local club started in 2013 and has plans for expansion to Lodi, Merced and Stockton. The clubs provide a safe environment for the vulnerable. Their mission is to enable all young people, especially those who need us most, to reach their full potential as productive, caring, responsible citizens. The club encourages the kids to do volunteer work. About 96% expect to graduate from high school. They operate at four locations in Modesto. The tuition is \$10 per student per year.

Daniel Perez, a personal trainer and healthy life instructor, partners with the club. He spoke to us about the importance of maintaining a healthy diet, normal weight and a physically active life. He said the many of the club's kids are overweight. His goal is to make them healthy.

The club needs about \$1 million a year. One of their fund raisers is this month and involves some spooky stuff. It would be great to take the grand kids to their haunted house.
