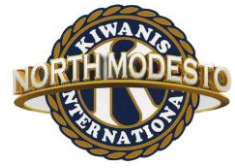

John Erro completed his apron reading today. Only one of those attending missed signing his apron so no real money raised there. Welcome John!

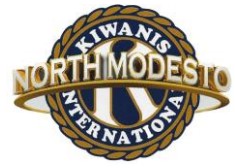
Brian Sanders was welcomed into the club today. Brian has been involved in many of our fund raisers as a volunteer. Welcome Brian.

KIWANIS INTERNATIONAL DUES PAYMENT

MORE THAN MEMBERS PAID

Kiwanis annual dues are \$200. Billings of \$100 each are sent out in March and September. Kiwanis International is paid 60% of the annual amount in November. The remaining 40% stays with our club. Everyone must pay their dues in order to remain a member in good standing and for the club to exist.

Some have fallen behind in dues. Club leadership is aware of circumstances that may affect the ability to pay on time. They have responded by offering to accept more frequent payments of a smaller amount until paid. If this will help, please contact the treasurer.

Next month the club will pay Kiwanis International significantly more money than it has received to date. The club must pay international dues on time or lose its good standing.

The club will work to accomplish its mission keeping all members. However, it is necessary to decide if we can continue to subsidize dues and still accomplish our mission.

Roger Suelzle has made great headway on the club meeting room set up. He has also completed research on location availability. There is a major push to improve food quality.

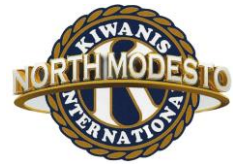
Since moving to the Clarion, the club has subsidized breakfast. The club cannot continue this practice because of income shortfalls in other areas.

Kevin Scott celebrated 23 years as an NMK member.

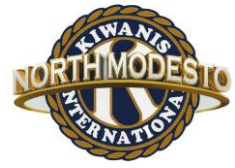
BIRTHDAYS

Gary Wasmund is excited to be heading to the Paso Robles area to be with Jim.

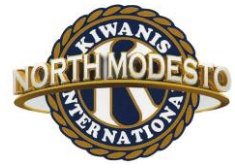

Ken Nolte was the lucky winner today \$42.

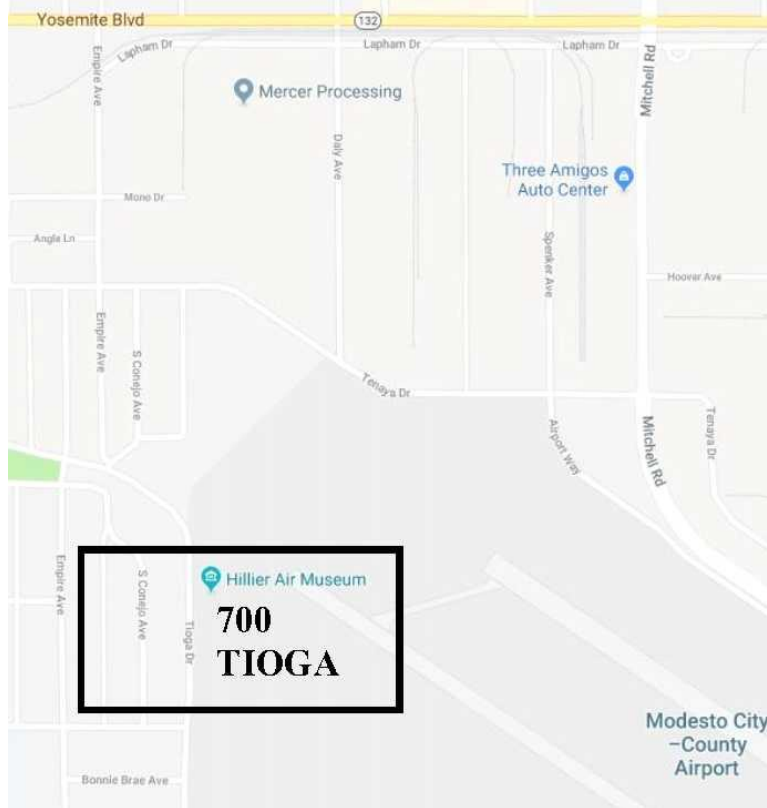

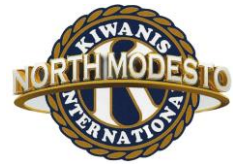
