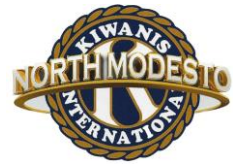

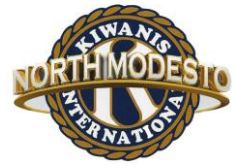
Eric Angelo fined himself for not wearing a badge. Kyle Barker had the wrong badge on but it was close to his alphabet "Sam Aguirre"!
