Lori Rosman announced she would make the DCM "much more exciting" when she becomes district governor.

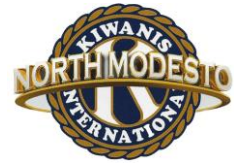
Chicken A Go Go season was kicked off today with Loren Suelzle handing out tickets and giving the order to "sell-sell-sell".

Steve Collins was very happy that his wife is taking some steps and recovering from a broken hip.

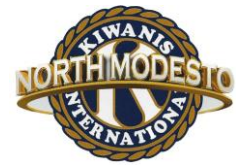
